- Once you have successfully added your post code. You now have the option to connect a <u>Licenced</u> <u>Hue Bridge</u> once the Hue Bridge is connected you can add up to 40 bulbs and 10 <u>Motion Sensors</u>
- In order to pair a Licensed Hue Bridge to your MyPlace system please first set up the Bridge by following the Phillips guide found <u>HERE</u>.
- Now that you have connected the Bridge, Light and Sensor through your mobile phone, you can link them to your MyPlace system.
 - 1. Your Wall Mounted Tablet must be connected to same Wi-Fi as your hue bridge.
 - 2. Go to Setup > options > Licensed Hue Bridge and press the setup button
 - 3. Follow the on screen instructions and press the link button on the Hue Bridge.
 - 4. Within 30 seconds tap the "Next" button on your MyPlace Tablet
 - 5. Your MyPlace Tablet and Hue Bridge will automatically sync.
